- Indirect Costs #2 "OHV Safety Clothing & Gear" - Contingent Line item. Applicant's narrative indicates the gear "may need replacing" but does not indicate an immediate need to replace items. In the event Applicant does need to replace items, they must work with their Grant Administrator for approval.
