


1. Beginning July 28, 2020, the following trails listed below are closed as indicated by "CLOSED AREA" on the Closure Map attached, and shall be closed to all recreational OHV riding until further notice due to Post Fire Rehabilitation. Every effort will be made to post all entrances and access points to the areas to notify the public.

2. EXCEPTIONS:
 - a. Employees of California State Parks, authorized volunteers, and any contractors employed by the Department.
 - b. Emergency Personnel (ie: CALFIRE, CHP, Sheriff, etc.)
3. This is a temporary closure that will allow the Department to rehabilitate the burned areas without further impacting the natural resources due to OHV riding in the critically affected burned areas. All efforts will be made to open up riding areas as signage and resource recovery is completed.
4. Nothing herein shall affect any existing concession contract, private contract or property rights.
5. Exceptions to this order may only be granted in writing by the Diablo Range District Superintendent, 15751 Tesla Road, Livermore, California 94550.
6. Nothing herein shall be construed in derogation of other provisions of law.
